


Experience and consistency are important requirements for quality. quality gives ideas a solid foundation on which they can develop. We are convinced that small details can make a big difference.

Details make all the difference.


We have designed our notebook very carefully - down to the last detail. The pages are numbered and there is an empty table of contents that makes it easier for you to organise your notes.

Master (A4+) | 225 × 315 mm Slightly larger than A4 so that loose A4 pages can be fully placed inside the notebook to prevent frayed edges.



Composition (B5) | 178 × 254 mm Iconic American size – smaller than A4 yet bigger than A5 – the same size as a tablet.



Medium (A5) | 145 × 210 mm A double page is just the right size for A4 photocopies.



Paperback (B6+) | 125 × 190 mm A convenient and compact format. Inspired by the size of a paperback book.




Pocket (A6) | 90 × 150 mm The size to carry around. Fits into the inside pocket of a jacket.






Notebook Ruling

















Plain

Clear, white pages. No margin, no date. Simply features the page number in the bottom corner. We also provide each plain notebook with a ruled and squared guideline page.

Dotted

Dots with 5 mm spacing provide a guide for writing, creating tables and drawings.

Ruled

Almost all sizes feature the standard 6 mm line spacing. Only our Master Classic notebook provides generous 8.5 mm line spacing on 235 pages. The notebooks in Master size have a side margin with space for commonts.

Squared

Available in all sizes and versions - squared with precise 5 x 5 mm boxes. For calculations, tables and drawings. Our Master notebooks also feature a margin.






Founded in 1883, Foundation of the Heidelberer Federhal-terfabrik (Heidelberg dip pen factory) by the gentlemen Luce and Englen. Although the Kaweco name was not listed in the Heidelberg directory until 1889. Wooden dip pens are produced; fountain pens and olden nibs are imported from Morton in New York. In 1994, The h & m gutberlet gmbh acquires the "KAWECO" name and relaunches a new Sport series based on the Kaweco Sport design from 1935. These nifty pocket writing instruments are available as fountain pens, rollerballs, ball pens, push pencils and clutch pencils. Diplomat becomes the exclusive sales partner. This business relationship is maintained until 1999, when Diplomat is sold.
